

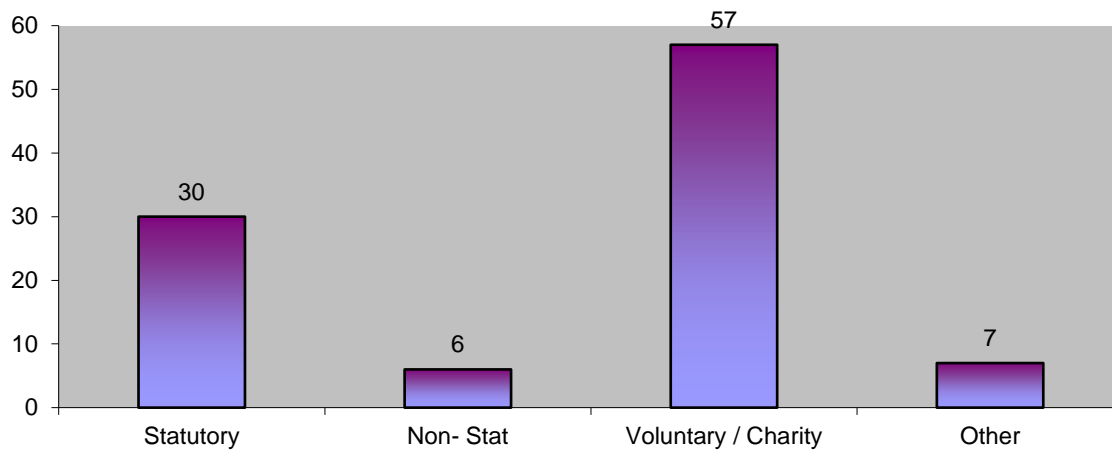

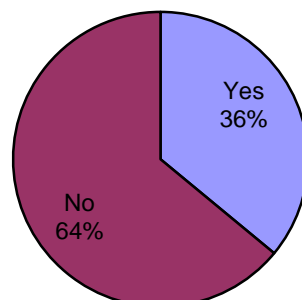
What type of organisation/service do you work in?	Number

Type of Organisation



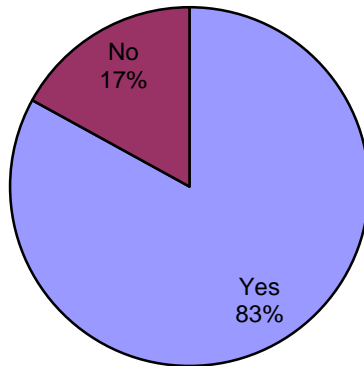

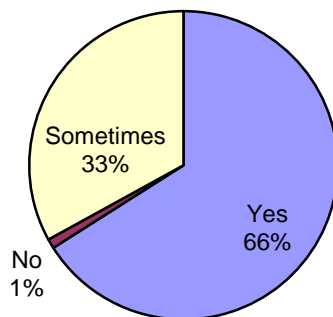

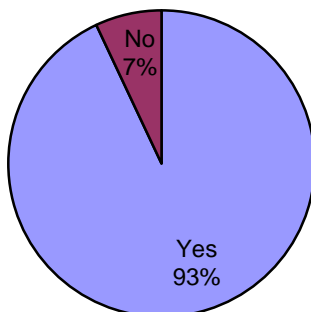

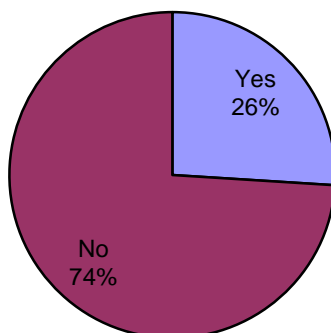

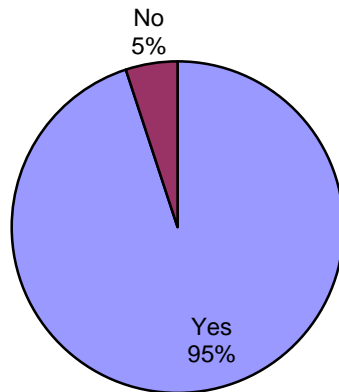
